KAYDENCE
It wasn't about you, Mason. My father was having a moment.

MASON
(sighing)
I get that, but I was the one you asked to leave.

KAYDENCE
He needed space. We're all trying to balance this new dynamic.

MASON

When do I become a priority in this dynamic?

KAYDENCE

(smiling softly, trying to lighten the mood)

Do you feel like I'm neglecting you?

MASON

Stop deflecting.

KAYDENCE

(taking his hand)

You are my present and my future, Mason. You know that.

MASON

(shaking his head)

I don't think there's enough room on your throne for both me and your father.

Kaydence looks at him, understanding his frustration, and pulls him closer.

KAYDENCE

There's plenty of room. But I need you to understand that he's my father, and this is hard for him too.

MASON

(softening a bit)

I just want to feel like I matter in all of this.

KAYDENCE

You do matter. More than you know. Just give me some time to make him see that too.

Mason takes a deep breath, nodding slowly.

MASON

Alright. But don't keep me waiting forever, Kaydence.

KAYDENCE

I won't. Promise.
