As Wax's signature raspy voice effortlessly stirs the conversation, JAFAR (24) sits glued to his left in his shadow while ESTELLE (24), ROMAN (24), and DORCAS (23) face off across from him.

Wax points everyone's attention to a particular wall.

WAX

Stop throwing everything at the wall, hoping something, anything sticks.

Wax points his finger to a distinct spot on the wall.

WAX (CONT'D)

Shoot a direct SHOT.

Wax turns his attention to Dorcas.

WAX (CONT'D)

Life is a fog without purpose!

DORCAS

I know my purpose.

WAX

What is it?

DORCAS

I'm here to help others.

WAX

Help others?!

Dorcas stiffens as she braces herself for the fight.

WAX (CONT'D)

That's too general.

DORCAS

General?

WAX

There is no way to measure "help others," so there is no way to fail.

DORCAS

Well, that's my purpose.

WAX

That's not a purpose.

DORCAS

It's my purpose.

WAX

What's the sacrifice?

DORCAS

Sacrifice?

While exhaling, a visibly frustrated Wax switches gears to approach the subject from a different angle.

WAX

To accomplish your purpose, you must sacrifice, which is often very bloody.

DORCAS

What?

WAX

Your purpose is hidden behind your fears.

DORCAS

(defensively)

I'm not afraid of anything!

Wax's disapproving stare declares war on Dorcas for her ignorant response.

WAX

You're misappropriating fear as a negative asset.

A frustrated Dorcas recoils in her chair as Estelle and Roman draw close to her for support.

As the outlier, Wax pulls back to gain a broader perspective on his opposition.

WAX (CONT'D)

(soft banter as if reminding

himself)

If you shoot your shots without a target, you can't miss. Nothing great is born as an afterthought. No focus is the attribute of the -

Wax pauses abruptly when Dorcas switches her attention to her phone.

WAX (CONT'D)

(directed at Dorcas)

- my time is too expensive!

Wax takes a moment for the sting of his words to land as he drags his focus down to Dorcas's phone as she turns her phone down.

DORCAS

I was checking on my mother.

Wax glances dismissively at the phone, eliminating the need for further correction.

DORCAS (CONT'D)

I cut it off.

WAX

THEY want what I have, but THEY won't pay the price.

DORCAS

Who is the THEY?

Roman and Estelle snicker in response to the comment and as a statement of unity against  $\mbox{Wax.}$ 

WAX

When friendship turns envious, it often manifests itself in the same way.

DORCAS

Come on back down to earth, Steven.

WAX

The formation of birds.

DORCAS

That's how they fly. Birds fly in formation.

WAX

(demeaning)

I see.

DORCAS

What's worse? To be a bird flying in formation with birds or a self-proclaimed eagle with nine-foot wings flying with little birds?

Ignoring the petty comment, Wax looks away.

DORCAS (CONT'D)

It's terrible when a pigeon who doesn't know who he is must look down on others to feel significant.

Dorcas issues a smile to soften the blow.
