BROOKLYN

(confused)

What?

DR. FLOYD

(serious)

I know how unsettling it is to hear a diagnosis contrary to what you want to hear.

BROOKLYN

(irritated)

You're not really saying anything.

DR. FLOYD

Josiah's not sleeping. He's-

BROOKLYN

(interrupting)

- What are you talking about? He's sleeping all day long.

Dr. Floyd raises his hand for her to stop talking.

DR. FLOYD

Josiah's not sleeping; he's in a state of depression.

BROOKLYN

(defensive)

Do you blame him?

DR. FLOYD

(gently)

Brooklyn...

BROOKLYN

(passionate)

If someone raped, imprisoned, and brutally beat you down, you would be depressed too!

DR. FLOYD

That's not why he's depressed.

BROOKLYN

(insistent)

He's in pain!

DR. FLOYD

I agree, but his mental pain is overshadowing his physical pain.

BROOKLYN

(defensive)

He's not gay!

DR. FLOYD

(cautious)

I wasn't questioning his sexuality.

BROOKLYN

(angry)

No, but you were tapping around it!

DR. FLOYD

Why specifically is his face not injured?

BROOKLYN

(frustrated)

Oh my God! When you're black, they always look for ways to blame the victim.

DR. FLOYD

I'm not clear if he was a victim.

BROOKLYN

(outraged)

What?

DR. FLOYD

I believe that Josiah may have been a willing participant.

BROOKLYN Are you fucking crazy?!

DR. FLOYD

No.

Overwhelmed with helplessness and frustration, Brooklyn's emotions surge, bringing her to tears.

BROOKLYN (tearfully)
He's dying right in front of us. Can you please help him?
